This course introduces several of the central topics in metaphysics. We will begin by focusing on foundational issues relating to the nature of things and properties, the relationship between things and their properties, and the nature of space and time. We then move on to study some applied metaphysics, covering topics including the problem of material constitution, the persistence of things over time, personal identity, the nature of mind, and freewill.
